

The ship of culture is finally in Aalborg!

This summer the 80-meter long and 2500-ton heavy cargo and cooling ship from the former eastern Germany will berth at Aalborg Harbour. The ship was originally built in 1964. In 1994, it was transformed into a mobile platform for music, cultural production, documentation and communication.



On the ship you will find a café and two large cargo compartments. These are turned into a giant party platform. Everything is kept original at the outside of the ship and this might trick you to think this is an old ship with nothing special to offer. However, wait until you get inside! The ship is fully renewed, and it offers the perfect boundaries for you to enjoy a great party in the most spectacular surroundings. For instance, from the café you observe the lower scene while you enjoy a cocktail in the bar, just before you might decide to hit the dance floor. Also, in the café, you can rest your tired feet, as it is possible to sit down at the custom made chairs kept in the original construction style of Stubnitz.

Two party areas with the utmost modern light- and sound systems are at your service. The massive sound systems onboard are ready to spoil even the most demanding and enthusiastic guests' ears. You can also have a walk on the huge deck where you can enjoy some fresh air or have an outstanding view over Aalborg. Everything on Stubnitz is carefully constructed to guarantee you an extraordinary atmosphere that you have never experienced before – at least not in Aalborg.
